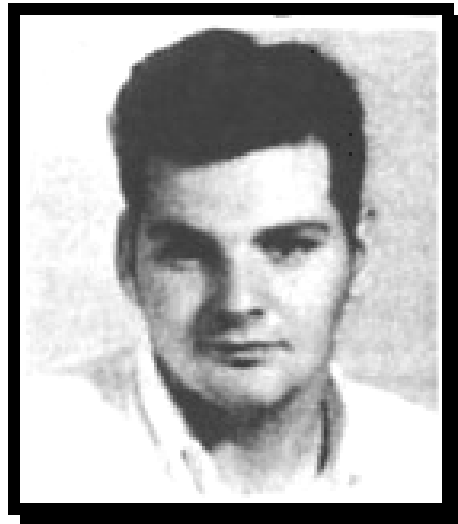

Chesterfield GI Dies in Vietnam

CHESTERFIELD TOWNSHIP – Army Sgt. Robert Charles Benoit, Jr., 21, son of Mrs. And Mrs. Robert C. Benoit, 25939 Brumer, died Sept. 7 from wounds suffered during combat operations in South Vietnam.

Army officials said he was admitted to a hospital after a booby trap detonated near him. He died later. Benoit was a June 1967 graduate of L'Anse Creuse High School. He entered the service in January, 1968 and arrived in Vietnam last December. He was attached to the First Infantry Division.

He is survived by his parents, a brother Larry Joseph, 12, and a sister Betty Ann, 20, Funeral arrangements are being made by the Cooley Funeral Home, Mount Clemens.
