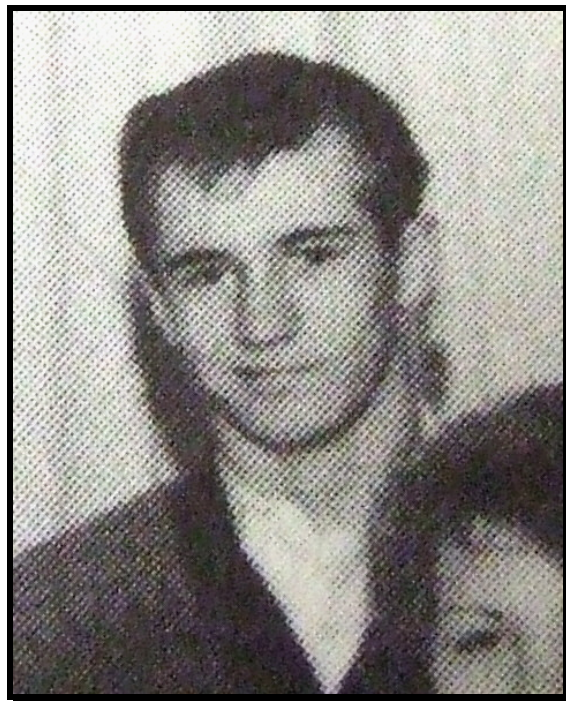

Shelby GI Dies of Veit Wounds

A Shelby Township GI has died in Walter Reed Hospital, Washington, D.C., from battle wounds received in South Vietnam three weeks ago, the Defense Department announced today.

The parents of Army PFC Wilfried Burck, 19, left Monday for Darmstadt-Eberstadt, West Germany, where funeral services will be held for their son.

PFC Burck was the only child of Mr. and Mrs. Guenther Burck, 50263 Cherry Tree.

A graduate of Utica Community High School, the soldier joined the Army in 1966 and had been in Vietnam since last fall.
