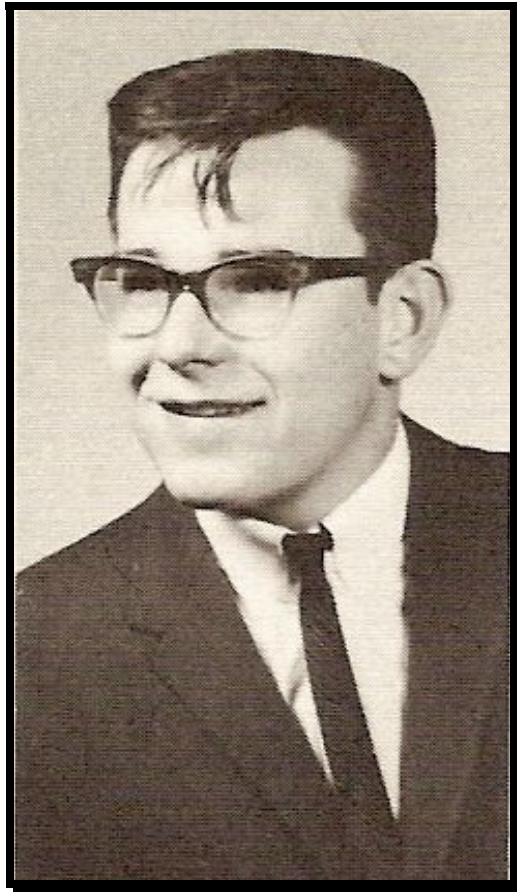

EAST DETROIT – Services for Sgt. Charles F. Cook, 22, a life-long resident of the city, will be held at 11 a.m. Saturday at the Clyne Funeral Home, 22322 Gratiot.

Rev. G.D. Everett, of Peace United Methodist Church, will officiate. Burial will be in Cadillac Memorial Gardens West, Garden City.

Born July 12, 1946 in Dearborn, he died March 28 in Vietnam as the result of a land mine explosion.

Sgt. Cook graduated from East Detroit High School in 1965 and attended Macomb Community College for two years before entering the Army in February 1968. He had been in Vietnam since January 1969.

Surviving are his father, Earl, of Highland Park; a brother Robert, of Florida; his foster-parents, Mr. and Mrs. Leo Vesco, of East Detroit.
