He was born Oct. 16, 1947, in Detroit, and lived with his family in St. Clair Shores the last 12 years.

He graduated from Notre Dame high School in Harper Woods in 1965 and attended the Detroit Institute of Technology, Lawrence Institute of Technology, and Macomb County Community College. He was drafted on Dec. 1, 1969, and left for Vietnam June 21, 1970.

Surviving are his parents, Stanley and Geneviene Gniewek of St. Clair Shores; his grandparents' Joseph and Anponina Mendyk of Michigan; another grandfather, Ignacy Gniewek.
