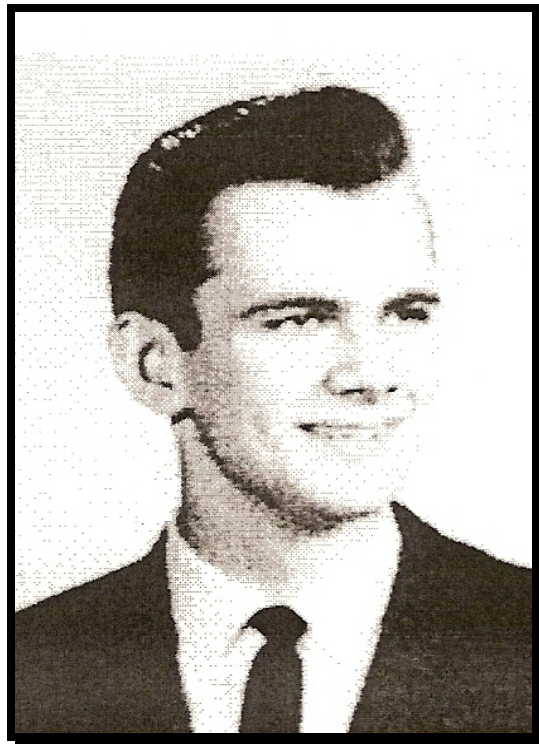

ROSEVILLE – PFC Gerald Goral, 20, son of Mr. and Mrs. Erving Goral, of 27820 Groveland, died April 30 in Vietnam as the result of wounds received in combat. A June 1967 graduate of Roseville High School, Goral was serving with the U.S. Army First Cavalry Division near the Cambodian border at the time of his death. Survivors include his parents and one brother, Dennis, of Roseville. Funeral arrangements are being conducted by the Kaul Funeral Home, 27830 Gratiot, Roseville.
