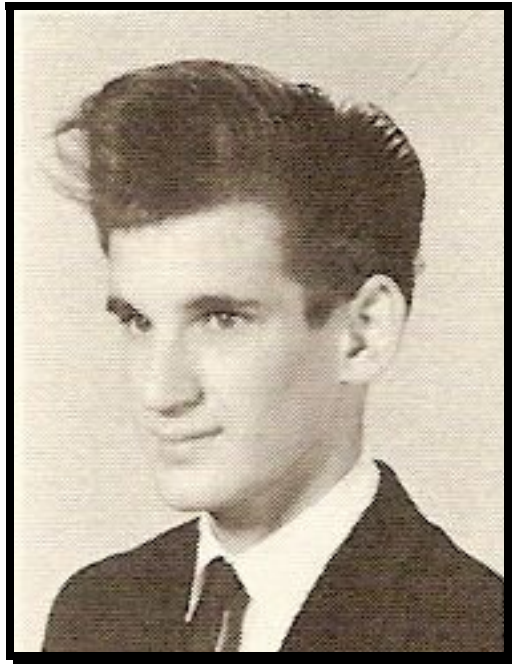

## **Pfc. Richard Hamilton**

EAST DETROIT – Services for Pfc. Richard L. Hamilton , 24, of 21746 Nevada, will be 1 p.m. Monday at Immanuel United Presbyterian Church, 23715 Gratiot, with the Rev. John N. Howell officiating. Burial will be in the honor circle for veterans at Cadillac Memorial Gardens East, Clinton Township.

Friends may call at the Clyne Funeral Home, 22322 Gratiot, after 7 p.m. today. The body will lie in-state at the church from noon to 1 p.m. Monday.

Pfc. Hamilton was killed in action Feb. 26 near Saigon, South Vietnam.

He was born in May 31, 1946 in Detroit and attended East Detroit High School until 1963 when he enlisted in the Army. He re-enlisted in 1968 and was sent to Vietnam Aug. 1, 1970.

Pfc. Hamilton is survived by his parents, Mr. and Mrs. Vincent Hamilton of East Detroit; three sisters, Mrs. Walter (Diane) Senska of Sterling Heights, Mrs. Vincent (Linda) Foltz of Roseville, and Debra at home, and his grandparents, Mr. and Mrs. Louis Gasperin of Florida.
