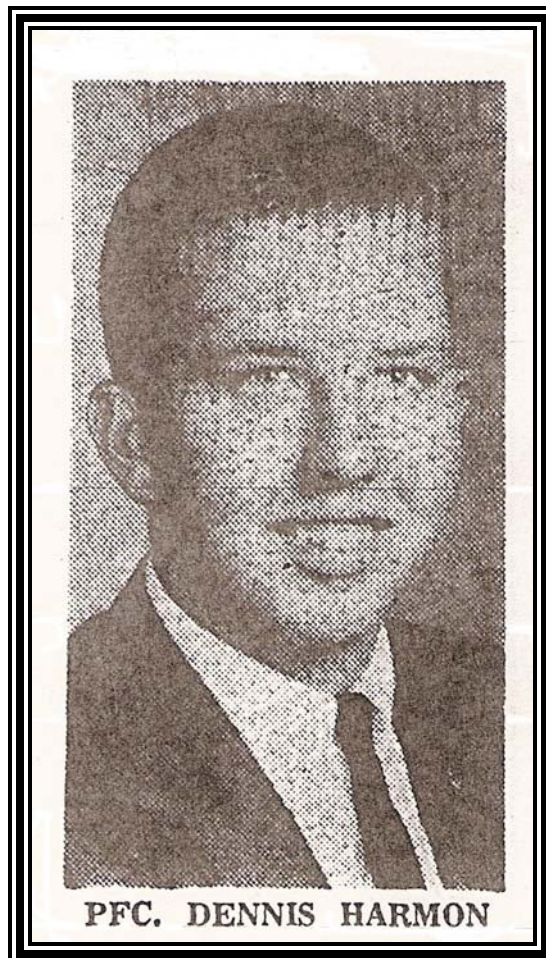

## **Richmond Marine Dies in Viet Nam**

RICHMOND – The department of the Navy has announced the death of a Richmond youth killed in action in Viet Nam.

Mrs. Inez Gordon Harmon, 69840 N. Main, Richmond, was notified Saturday that her 19-year-old son, Marine Pfc. Dennis Harmon, was killed in Viet Nam last Thursday.

Pfc. Harmon was serving in Viet Nam with the 3<sup>rd</sup> Battalion, 4<sup>th</sup> Regiment, 3<sup>rd</sup> Marine Division.

A 1965 graduate of Armada High School, young Harmon was an outstanding athlete and also participated in many extracurricular programs. He was on the junior Varsity football team and a member of the varsity team for three years. He also played varsity basketball during the junior and senior years.

The handsome youth was a member of the student council, served as its vice-president, and was vice-president of his senior class. A Varsity Club member for several years, he was its president during his senior year. Dennis took time out from athletics for other interests and was a member of the cast for his junior class play.

He is the son of the late George Harmon of Richmond. He has a sister, Clare, who is a nurse.

Funeral arrangements, being made by Hensch Memorial Chapel Funeral Home in Richmond, are incomplete.
