ST. CLAIR SHORES – Mr. and Mrs. Richard L. Herrington, Sr. are awaiting the body of their son, killed in Vietnam May 19, to plan funeral arrangements.

Roy J. Kaul Funeral Home, 28433 Jefferson, will handle the arrangements when the body of Pfc. Richard L. Herrington Jr. does arrive.

He was killed when the military aircraft on which he was a door gunner was hit by enemy fire and crashed.

He entered the army in September 1969 and was sent to Vietnam in April. He was a 1967 graduate of Lake Shore High School.

His mother and father live at 23308 Brookdale, with his brothers George and Thomas, His sister, Mrs. Sandra Irwin, lives in Grand Rapids.

The death of Army Sgt. Michael J. Maniere, son of Mr. and Mrs. Robert R. Maniere, of St. Clair Shores, was also reported by the Defense Department Monday.

No other details were immediately forthcoming in the recent DOD report, which listed Sgt. Maniere as killed in combat in Southeast Asia.
