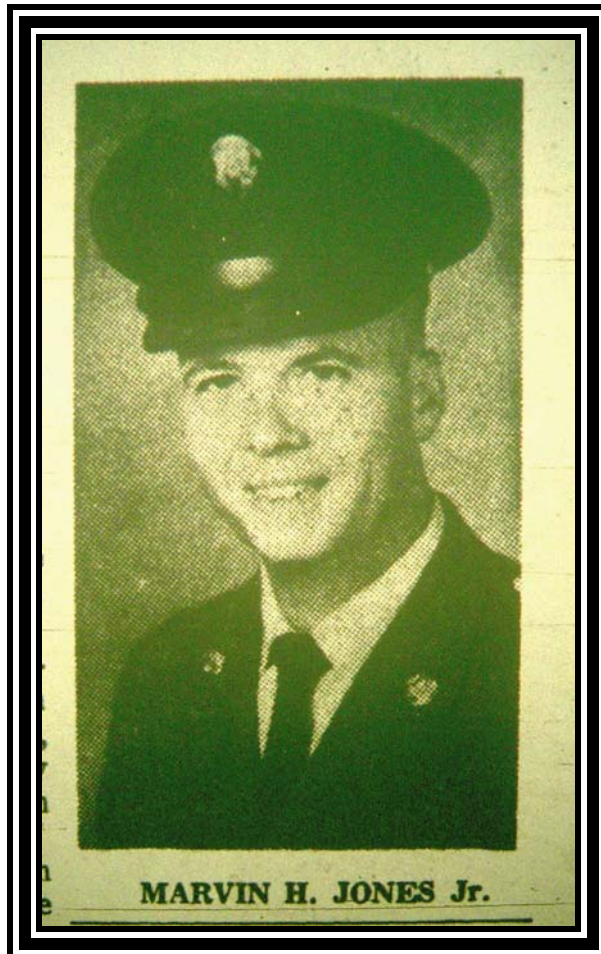


MARVIN HAROLD JONES JR

Mount Clemens – Full military services for Army Pfc. Marvin H. Jones, Jr., 23, of 130 Morose, will be held at 10 a.m. Wednesday at the Hubbard Funeral Home, 71 N. Ave., with an Army chaplain officiating.

Stationed in Vietnam, Jones was listed as missing in action on Jan. 31. His death was confirmed in February.

Pfc. Jones entered the military service in July 1967 and was stationed with C troop, 4th Cavalry, first Infantry division.

He arrived in Vietnam on Dec. 22, 1967.

BEFORE entering the service, he operated the Jones Machine Co., 197 Grand Ave., Mount Clemens.

Born April 24, 1942, he was the son of Marvin H. and Mable (Peltier) Jones.

In addition to his parents, Pfc. Jones is survived by a brother, Mickey, at home; three sisters, Mary who also lives at home, Mrs. Dennis (Mable) Moran of Mount Clemens and Mrs. Fredrick (Marie) Gray of Mount Clemens.

Burial will be in Clinton Grove Cemetery.
