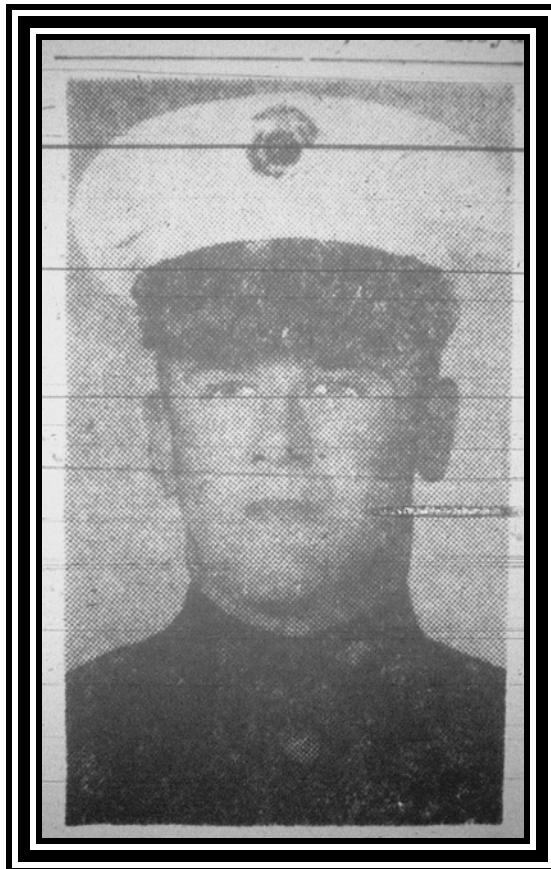

Area Marine Killed in Viet Battle

ROMEO – Marine Lance Cpl. David Bruce Koenig, 21, became Macomb County's most recent casualty in the Vietnam war when he was killed in action Wednesday at Dang Hoa. His parents, Mr. and Mrs. Paul Koenig, of 69100 Powell, were notified of their son's death on Thursday.

Koenig teaches fifth grade at Flickinger Elementary School in Utica.

Cpl. Koenig graduated from St. Augustine High School in Richmond in 1964. He enlisted in the Marine Corps on April 14, 1966, and had been in Vietnam for seven months.

Besides his parents, Cpl. Koenig is survived by two brothers; Lawrence and Eugene, at home.

Funeral arrangements for marine Lance Cpl. David Bruce Koenig, 21, 69100 Powell, Romeo, are delayed pending word of the arrival of his body from Vietnam where he was killed in action at Dang Hoa.
