## **Roseville Soldier Dies in Vietnam**

Roseville – A 21-year-old Army private was killed in Vietnam Tuesday, his parents learned Thursday.

PFC Frank J. Krebs, son of Mr. and Mrs. Jacob Krebs, 30504 Quinkert, died when his helicopter disintegrated in midair.

Maj. Gen. Kenneth J. Wickham told Mr. and Mrs. Krebs in an official telegram that Frank's helicopter was on combat support mission when the incident occurred. The exact cause is unknown, the telegram said.

He is also survived by his wife, Cynthia, who lives in Schaller, Iowa, three brothers and a sister at home.

PFC Krebs attended South Lake High School in St. Clair Shores, and was employed at Warren Die Casting, Warren, before he was drafted in October 1965.
