## **PFC Fredrick Kunna**

Services for PFC Fredrick Kunna, 20,30420 South River Road, Harrison Township, will be at 3 p.m. Wednesday at the Groesbeck Funeral Home, 226 Crocker, Mount Clemens. Kunna will be buried with full military honors at Cadillac Memorial Gardens East, Clinton Township.

Kunna was killed March 20 by enemy fire in Vietnam in the big push of the 4<sup>th</sup> Infantry Division, 3<sup>rd</sup> Brigade, against the Viet Cong near the Cambodian border.

Born Nov. 8, 1946, he was the son of Mr. and Mrs. Robert Kunna. A graduate of L'Anse Creuse High School, he was employed by Mount Clemens Pottery prior to joining the Army in January 1966.

In addition to his parents he is survived by five brothers and sisters: Robert, Jr., Margaret, Barbara, Raymond and Richard, all living at home; parental grandparents, Mr. and Mrs. Joseph Konna, of Roseville, and maternal grandmother, Mrs. Mildred Gibbs, of Fort Meyers, Fla.
