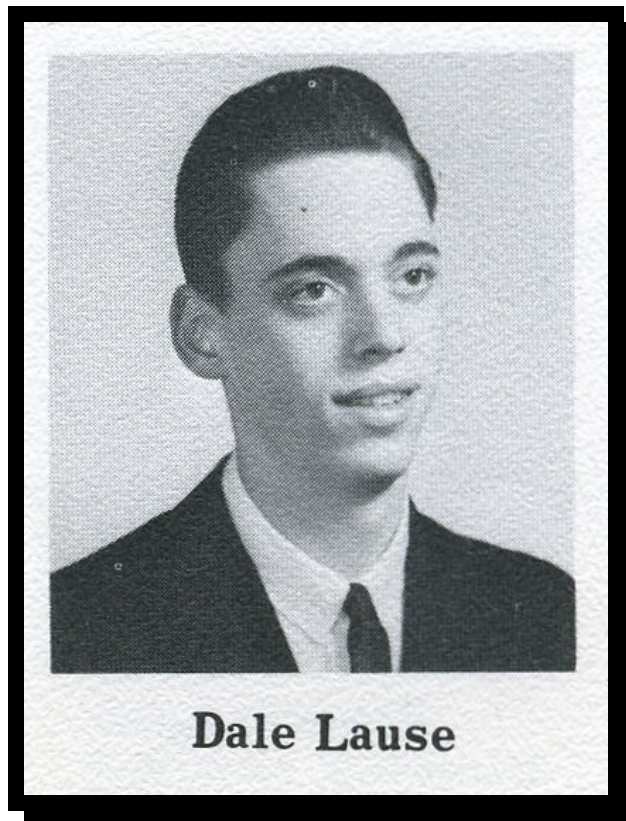

ROSEVILLE - A full military burial in Resurrection Cemetery, Clinton, will be accorded Saturday to SP-4 Dale M. Lause, 20, who died in action last Saturday in Vietnam.

The graveside rites will follow an 11 a.m. requiem mass in Sacred Heart Church, which will be offered by the Rev. Father Thadeus Fujaus.

Mr. Lause, a 1965 graduate of Roseville High School was serving with the 47th Infantry, Company C, 3rd Battalion in Vietnam when he was killed.

He was born Oct. 12, 1946, in Detroit. He played in the Roseville Band.

He is survived by his parents, Mr. and Mrs. Frank Lause, 27807 Garfield, two brothers, Gary of Dearborn Heights, Wayne, who lives at home; a sister, Sharon, who also lives at home, and his maternal grandparents, Mr. and Mrs. Ostendorf, Port Jennings, Ohio.

Brief services at 10:30 a.m. Saturday at the Kaul Funeral Home, 27830 Gratiot, will precede the Mass.

A rosary will be recited at 8 p.m. Friday at the funeral home.
