WARREN – Services for PFC Jeffery L. Ledford, 21, 1<sup>st</sup> Cavalry, U. S. Army, will be at 1 p.m. Wednesday at Gideon Baptist Church, Warren, conducted by Rev. John M. Jones, pastor of Fellowship Baptist Church, Detroit. Burial will be in White Chapel Cemetery, Troy.

PFC Ledford was killed in action in Viet Nam on Aug. 1. He was born July 4, 1945, in Detroit, the son of Barney and Ivalea Ledford. In October, 1965 he married Kay Holladay, of Warren. He entered the Army in November, 1965 and reported for duty in Viet Nam on May 1.

He is survived by his widow; his parents; a brother, Sp.4 Barney E. Ledford, 119<sup>th</sup> Aviation Company, Vietnam and a sister, Miss Sharon Ledford, Warren.
