WARREN – The son of a Warren resident will be buried in Boone, N.C. when his body arrives from Vietnam.

Capt. Eugene Stewart Miller, 25, the son of Emmerson S. Miller, of 7012 Prospect, and Mrs. Miller of San Diego, Calif., was pronounced missing in Action May 23.

His remains were identified from a crashed plane and his family notified May 29.

He graduated from Appalachian High School in Boone, N. C. in 1962 and Attended Macomb County Community College for three and a half years before entering the service in 1967. He was shipped to Vietnam, August 1969.

Reins-Sturdivant Funeral Home in Boone, N.C. will handle the arrangements. He is also survived by a sister, Mrs. L'Vaun Durbin of Santa Rosa, N.M.
