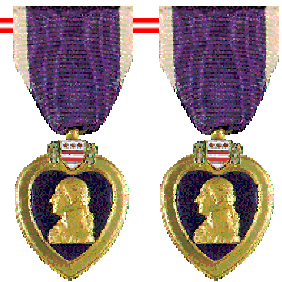

Requiem mass will be said at 10 a.m. in St. Peter Church, with the Rev. Father Lawrence Jackson officiating.

Burial will be in Resurrection Cemetery, Clinton Township, with full military honors. Born in Detroit, Sept. 14, 1946, he is the son of Mrs. Ruth Mullin and the late John E. Mullin.

He was a 1967 graduate of Mount Clemens High School, and a former track team member. He has been in the Marines since graduation.

Surviving are his wife, Barbara; three brothers, John and Michael, of Mount Clemens; Patrick, a Marine at Camp Pendleton, Calif., and a sister, Carol, of Mount Clemens.
