Two county GI's were included in the list of 32 servicemen killed in action in the Vietnam war, the U.S. Defense Department announced.

Dead are Army Spec. 4 Benjamin L. Hoopengartner, Jr. son of Mrs. Elsie M. Davenport, of 16435 Millar, Clinton Township, and Army Spec. 4 John Pizzuti, son of Mr. and Mrs. Angelo Pizzuti, of 22501 Alger, St. Clair Shores.

Pizzuti had been listed as missing on an earlier Defense Department report.
