ROSEVILLE – Services will be held Friday for Randall B. Prinz, 18, who was killed in action in Viet Nam April 11, where he was fighting with the First Infantry Division. Born August 19, 1947, he was the son of Mr. and Mrs. Rudolf Prinz, 25207 Dale, Roseville, and had lived in Roseville for the past 16 years and attended Roseville high school. He enlisted in the U. S. Army on Oct 19, 1964, and was sent to Viet Nam in June, 1965.

Survivors are his parents; a brother, Neil, at home and maternal grandparents, Mr. and Mrs. Marvin Edwards of Kentucky.

Services will be conducted Friday at 11 a.m. at the Kaul Funeral Home, 27830 Gratiot, with the Rev. Forest F. Friese, pastor of the Bethlehem Lutheran Church, Roseville, officiating.
