A 1967 graduate of Lake Shore High School, he enlisted Sept. 15, 1967 and went to Vietnam Sept. 15, 1968. He served with Company A, third Battalion, 60<sup>th</sup> Infantry, Ninth Division.

He is survived by his parents, Mr. and Mrs. Earl C. Rider, three brothers, Alan, Richard and Ralph, and a sister, Mrs. Kathleen Borborian, of Allen Park.
