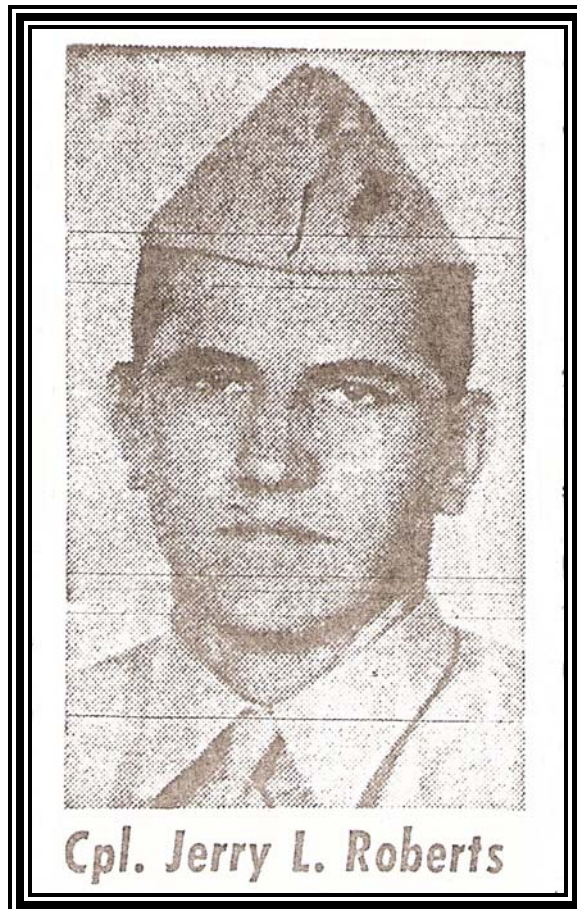

Cpl. Jerry Lee Roberts will be buried Monday in the town he left two years ago to join the U. S. Marines.

Cpl. Roberts, 20, son of Mr. and Mrs. Ernest F Schuldt, 124 North Wilson, was killed in action in Viet Nam two weeks ago.

Born in Mount Clemens on April 19, 1945, to Charles L. and Gail Cook Roberts, he graduated from Mount Clemens High School in 1963 and entered the Marine Corps on July 11, 1963. He had been in Viet Nam since June.

Full military honors will be accorded him by the First Battalion, 24th Marines, 4th Marine Division.

Surviving are his mother and step-father, Mr. and Mrs. Ernest F. Schuldt, 124 North Wilson, Mount Clemens, a sister, Linda, living at home and two brothers, Ray and Harold Roberts, both of Mount Clemens.

Funeral services will be held on Monday afternoon at 1 p.m. at the Will & Schwarzkoff Funeral Home, 233 North Gratiot Avenue, Mount Clemens.

Burial will take place in the Clinton Grove Cemetery.
