## **Gregory P. Rugenstein**

ROSEVILLE – Sgt. Gregory P. Rugenstein, 24, son of Dr. and Mrs. Edward Rugenstein, 19415 Rock, was killed in Vietnam Friday.

He had been in Vietnam only 15 days, serving as a helicopter inspector assigned to the 4<sup>th</sup> Infantry Division.

Born in Detroit in 1945, Rugenstein graduated from Roseville High School in June 1963 and joined the Army Dec. 7, 1964.

He is survived by his wife, Yong, whom he married in January 1968 while stationed in Korea, and a daughter Sheila. Also surviving are his parents; two sisters, Mrs. Adrian (Cynthia) Hunter of Havertown, Pa., Mary Louise, at home, and a brother, SP-4 Arthur Rugenstein, now serving in Vietnam.
