HARRISON TWP. – SP-4 Donald A. Selkey, Jr., of 28222 South River Road, died on Dec. 21, as the result of wounds he received in Vietnam.

He was born in Astoria, Ore. July 2, 1950, a son of Donald and Alma Jackson Selkey, Sr. In 1968 he was graduated from L'Anse Creuse High School and a member of the L'Anse Creuse Ski Club and the National Rifle Association. On Aug. 23, 1968, Donald enlisted in the United States Army and had been in Vietnam since March 12, 1969. While in Vietnam he was stationed at Duc Pho with the 174th Aviation Company, Americal Division.

Surviving are his parents, Donald and Alma Selkey, Sr. and a brother, Ronald living at home. Also surviving is his maternal grandmother, Mrs. Ima Lipe, of Utica.

Funeral services will be held 9:30 Wednesday at the Will and Schwarzkoff Funeral Home, 233 North Gratiot Avenue, Mount Clemens and 10 a.m. at St. Hubert Catholic Church with the Rev. Father Ladislaus Borowski, as celebrant. The rosary will be recited on Tuesday evening at 8:00 o'clock. Burial will be in Resurrection Cemetery with full military honors.
