STERLING HEIGHTS - Mark Surber, 20, formerly of Sterling Heights, was killed in action while having served in Vietnam for less than a month.

His family has been notified by the Defense Department that he was killed Sept. 22.

An eight-year resident of Sterling Heights and a former Chrysler employee, he is the son of Mrs. Fay Surber of Bloomington, Ind., where funeral services will be conducted.

Surviving is an older brother, Steve, stationed with the U. S. Army at Ft. Bliss, Tex.; two younger brothers, Joe and Jeff, at home in Indiana; and a sister, Mrs. Kay Wasniak of Sterling Heights.

A former Utica High School student, he entered the service April 1, 1969 and was transferred to Vietnam as an infantryman Aug. 26.
