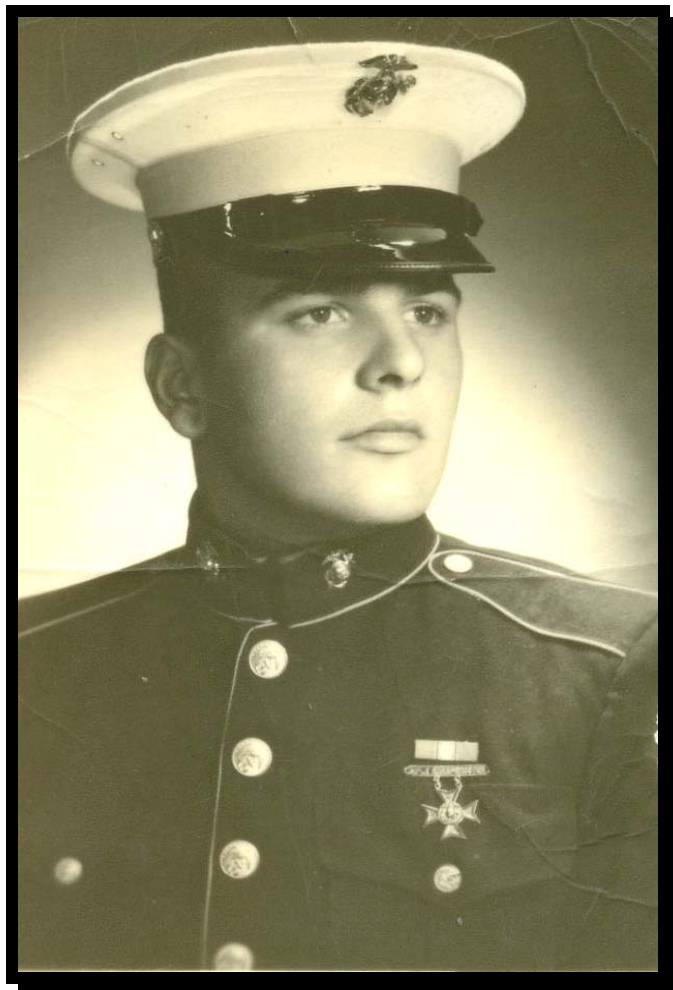
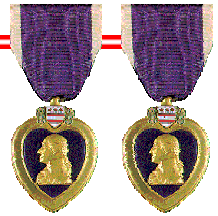

Marine Lance Cpl. Michael Synod, 18, son of Mr. and Mrs. John Synod of 696 St. Clair, Grosse Pointe, was buried Tuesday in Mount Olivet Cemetery, Detroit. Funeral services were held Wednesday at the Assumption Greek Orthodox Church in Detroit.

Cpl. Synod a former Roseville resident was killed in combat Nov. 1 in Quang Nam, Vietnam five days after he had returned to combat after being wounded and hospitalized. He was awarded the Purple Heart for the wounds he received.

Synod was graduated from Roseville High School and had served in the Marine Corps for 15 months.

Besides his parents, he was survived by three brothers, Dennise, John, and James, and one sister, Ann, who live at home.
