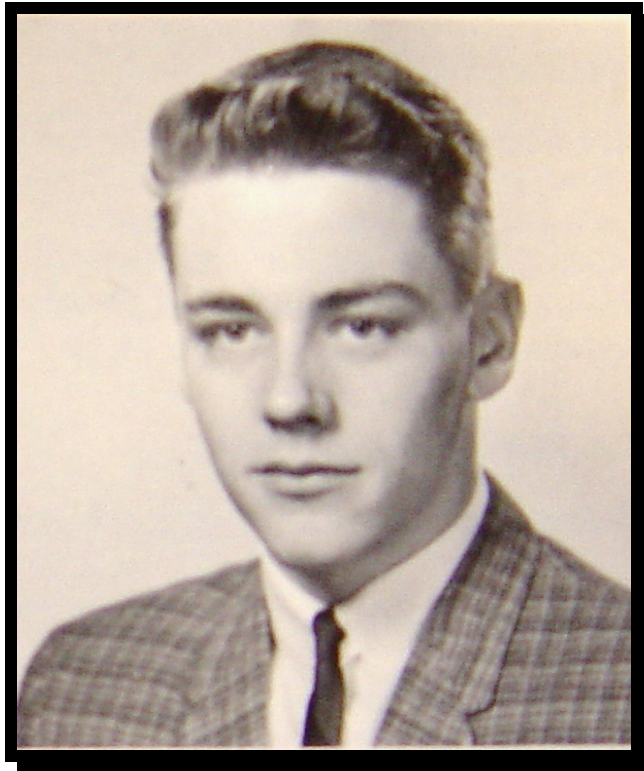

A requiem mass for Pvt. Terence R. Tangen, 20, 22935 Shiell, Clinton Township, who was killed in action in Vietnam, will be offered at 11:30 a.m. Saturday at St. Valerie of Ravenna Church by the Rev. Father Sylvester Radziecki, pastor.

The mass will be preceded by services at the Groesbeck Funeral Home., 226 Crocker Blvd. at 11:00 a.m.

Pvt. Tangen, a Marine, sustained fatal wounds June 5 when he stepped on a land mine. He died aboard the U.S.S. Repose June 10.

He was born April 18, 1946, in Latchford Warrington, England, the son of Kenneth and France Rigby Tangen.

Pvt. Tangen had lived in Mount Clemens most of his life and was a 1965 graduate of Mount Clemens High School.

He is survived by his parents; three sisters, Kathleen, Elizabeth and Moira and two brothers; John and Stephen, all at home.

Burial will be in Resurrection Cemetery.
