EAST DETROIT – Funeral services with full military honors, will be held Saturday for Pfc. Larry M. Wiginton USMC, of 17224 Wilson, who was killed in action June 10, at Da Nang, South Viet Nam. He was 18.

He left school in East Detroit to enlist in the Marines in February 1965 and was sent to Viet Nam in August 1965. Prior to his death he had been awarded a Purple Heart, The Vietnamese Service Medal and the national Defense Medal.

The Rev. Dewey Hanner of the Fundamental Baptist Church of Detroit will officiate at services at the William D. Clyne Funeral Home, 22322 Gratiot, East Detroit. Burial, with full military honors, will be in Forest Lawn Cemetery, Detroit.

Surviving are his parents, Elbert H. Wiginton and Mrs. Eleanor Killey; a sister, Mrs. Sherry Croizer of East Detroit, and brothers: Gregory, Keith, and Kevin, of East Detroit. Also surviving are a grandfather, Geore E. Carter, and a grandmother, Mrs. Mirtie Wiginton, both of Alabama.
